




-AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION OF SEARCH WARRANT

I, Detective Sergeant Gary F. Hayward, of the Topsfield Police Department, depose and state as follows:

- 1. I am currently assigned to investigations and patrol for the Topsfield Police Department, where I have worked for the past 25 years, 16 of those years as a full-time officer. Throughout the course of my career I have investigated numerous incidents and conducted several multi-jurisdictional investigations regarding the various offenses. I have received specialized training in investigations which have included training in search and seizure. I have applied for and/or participated in 54 search warrants.
- 2. I have probable cause to believe that evidence of the crime of Threat to Commit a Crime M.G.L. c. 275, ss2-4, Possession of a Hoax Device or Substance, M.G.L. c. 266, ss 102A1/2, will be found at 18 Washington Street, Topsfield, the residence of Daniel Morley, DOB 02/05/86.
- 3. 18 Washington Street is a one floor family structure, belonging to Glenda Duckworth and David Bloss. The residence also contains a wooden shed located to the southwest of the property. This officer is familiar with the residence and has been to the residence recently on three separate occasions. Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss have signed a Consent to Search form recently.
- 4. On 6/9/2013 at approx. 0240 hrs., I, Det. Sgt. Gary Hayward, was notified of an active domestic violence situation at the residence of 18 Washington Street. Dispatcher Alleruuzzo advised me that police units were dispatch to the area of the Topsfield Commons for a woman in a bathrobe waving her hands. The woman, later identified as Glenda Duckworth, DOB 7/15/45 and her boyfriend, later identified as David Bloss, DOB 7/11/49, told officers that Ms. Duckworth's son, Daniel Morley, DOB 2/5/86, was out of control and threatened to burn the house down. Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss, advised the officers that Mr. Morley had a large knife in the home and a rifle with ammunition. I then responded to the scene.
- 5. Upon my arrival, I observed Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss sitting on a bench outside the Town Library. In speaking with both parties, they informed me that Daniel was completely out of control and according to Ms. Duckworth she has never seen Daniel this bad. She described Daniel as being "very dark" and unstable. Ms. Duckworth stated that Daniel has had three instances this week but always calmed down, however this by far is the worst she has seen. According to both subjects Daniel mentioned "burning the house down or possibly doing harm to himself. Daniel did have access to a rifle with ammunition and at least one knife. During Daniel's tirade, Ms. Duckworth advised me that Daniel had grabbed her by the face and wrote on her face, Mr. Bloss advised me that Daniel had jumped on him in bed as he was sleeping grabbed his face so he was immobilized and stated "we have to talk". Both parties found an opportunity to escape and jumped out of a window of the residence. Both parties were visibly upset and appeared somewhat in shock.



- 6. Due to the statements made by Mr. Morley to both subjects, the accessibility and type of weapons involved and officer safety reasons, the area surrounding the residence of 18 Washington Street was secured and motor vehicle traffic was detoured. The Mass. State Police STOP team was contacted and subsequently dispatch to our location. A Command Center was established at the Emerson Center which was comprised of Topsfield Police and Fire, Medical personnel, State Police Negotiators and State Police STOP team.
- 7. Attempts to establish contact with Daniel were unsuccessful and entry to the residence was made. Daniel was ordered out of the house and placed into custody. Daniel was assessed and it was determined that Daniel should be transported to Beverly Hospital for further evaluation. Daniel was then transported to Beverly Hospital while being monitored by Officer James Dunn for safety reasons. Officer Gary Wildes followed behind the ambulance.
- 8. A check of Daniel's room was conducted for weapons. During this check a rifle, handgun and multiple rounds of ammunition were located.
- 9. As I continued to check the closet, I located a large pressure cooker under clothing as well as fertilizer. I recognized the items as items used in bomb making. The building was immediately evacuated.
- 10. Officer Wildes was asked to check with Mr. Morley regarding the pressure cooker. Officer Wildes stopped the ambulance and advised me that Mr. Morley stated the cooker was an active bomb
- 11. The area around the residence was secured, traffic again was diverted and the Mass. State Police Bomb Squad was requested. Officers began evacuating neighbors of the residence and The Emerson Center was re-opened for a Command Center.
- 12. In evaluating the situation, we were still uncertain of the contents of the home and if this was the only device. We still did not know the contents of the device or the potency. National Grid was contacted to have the gas service shut down. Due to the increase of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic, more officers were requested to the scene to better secure the perimeter.
- 13. The State Police Bomb Squad arrived and checked the contents of the device and found the device claimed to be an active bomb was empty. They further checked the property and eventually cleared the residence. Bomb Squad members advised us that some of the material they viewed could be components of a device and a further check should be conducted.
- 14. On the hutch and table there were two note books that were opened, there were more computer parts, a flashlight with the battery holder removed and a green stuffed animal that was burnt. The notebooks contained different drawings, notes, etc.. One page of drawings depicted a Nazi swastika inside the Star of David. There were formulas written in the book also. One formula in particular was the formula for Thermate.
- 15. On Monday June 10, 2013, I interviewed Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss about the incident and Daniel. They stated Daniel's best friend was Marc Pasciuto of Medford. Mr. Bloss stated that Marc was someone who we should check out. They felt that Marc was more volatile that Daniel. Ms. Duckworth stated that Daniel had broken off the relationship with Marc approx. two weeks prior. Daniel then became more reclusive and began to drink some alcohol, something that he not normally did. Daniel advised his mother that he separated from Marc



because Marc was attempting to have him do something really bad, that Daniel did not want to do. He advised his mother that he needed to get away from his friends and start fresh. The evening prior to the assault, Daniel and his mother were conversing at the kitchen table when Daniel stated "I'm sorry for what I've done with Marc and I will have to answer only to God". Daniel would not elaborate on what was done.

- 16. Due to the facts, the FBI and JTTC (Joint Terrorism Task Force) were contacted :
- Daniel Morley had items consistent with bomb making materials.
- Daniel Morley stated to his mother that he and his friend Marc Pasciuto had done things that he could only answer to God for.
- Daniel Morley stated to his mother that Marc Pasciuto was trying to get Daniel to do something real bad, therefore Daniel broke off the relationship.
- Daniel Morley told both Mr. Bloss and Ms. Duckworth that Marc Pasciuto stated he boxed with or boxed against Tamerlan Tzarnaev, the suspect in the Boston Marathon bombing.
- Daniel Morley had a Russian friend only know as "Vlad".
- The pressure cooker and other items were purchased prior to the Boston Marathon bombing.
- Daniel Morley had strong anti-government beliefs as well as anti-Semetic beliefs.
- A painting located on a temple made by Daniel Morley was analyzed by Dr. Breen, an expert as possibly containing a skyline in Boston and a plane that may be a potential target area.
- 17. A full report regarding the investigation is attached.

This affiant seeks permission to search the residence at 18 Washington Street, Topsfield, Mass. where Daniel Morley has joint access or control for the following items:

- 1. Any part, product or ingredient that may be an element or consistent with items used in the making of a bomb or infernal machine.
- 2. Any notes, drawings, paperwork or literature consistent to psychological, anti-Semitism, anti-government or other motive driven causes.
- 3. Any firearms ammunition or weapons.

A check of Daniel's room was conducted for weapons. During this check a rifle, handgun and multiple rounds of ammunition were located.



The rifle a Moison Nagant M44 was loaded with 4 rounds of 7.62x54R ammunition and an additional 9 7.62 x 54R rounds on the stock.

The handgun, a Ruger Mark II target pistol, 22 caliber, was unloaded, however there was two fully loaded 10 round clips with the weapon along with one empty clip in the case.


There were boxes of ammunition with the weapons along with plastic flex cuffs . Plastic flex cuffs are most commonly used to secure individuals.


The ammunition located was:








Several hundred rounds of 22LR 36gr. Ammunition

In addition, 42 rounds of 7.62x54R ammunition:




The ammunition appears to be Russian made ammunition. In researching the ammunition it appears this round was used for Russian military. It does denote that the round can be used for hunting medium or larger size game.

In Total 55 rounds of 7.62x54R were located

While checking the house for other weapons, I observed several knives and swords. I also observed several computer parts, wires, ball bearings and dismantled phones throughout the room. I checked the closet and found a shoebox with bird parts inside, there were air holes cut into the top of the shoebox.




A Consent to search the residence was signed by the home owners, Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss at 0708 hrs.

The temple had decorative swords on each corner, shotgun and other firearm ammunition casings. There was a painted picture near the center of the temple of a man holding a gun in one hand and holding a heart in the other. A skyline was painted in the background with a plane in the left hand corner.




AMMUNITION CASINGS FOUND ON TEMPLE




DECORATIVE SWORDS FOUND ON EACH END OF THE TEMPLE



PAINTING FOUND NEAR CENTER OF TEMPLE



We were informed by Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss that Daniel had spent a great amount of time in the shed to the rear of the residence, as well as the back screened in parch area. Officers checked the shed and located steel wool, a commercial grade bar of aluminum, a coffee grinder with metal shavings inside, more computer parts, a stenciled traffic sign, more flex cuffs, another fire starter and a machete.











Thermate is a variation of <u>thermite</u> and is an <u>incendiary pyrotechnic composition</u> that can generate short bursts of very high temperatures focused on a small area for a short period of time. It is used primarily in <u>incendiary grenades</u>.

The main chemical reaction in thermate is the same as in thermite: an <u>aluminothermic reaction</u> between powdered <u>aluminium</u> and a <u>metal oxide</u>. In addition to thermite, thermate also contains <u>sulfur</u> and sometimes <u>barium nitrate</u>, both of which increase its thermal effect, create <u>flame</u> in burning, and significantly reduce the ignition temperature [1] Various mixtures of these compounds can be called thermate, but to avoid confusion with thermate-TH3, one can refer to them as thermite variants or analogs. The composition by weight of **Thermate-TH3** (in military use) is 68.7% thermite, 29.0% barium nitrate, 2.0% sulfur and 0.3% <u>binder</u> (such as <u>PBAN</u>). As both thermite and thermate are notoriously difficult to ignite, initiating the reaction normally requires supervision and sometimes persistent effort.

Because thermate burns at higher temperatures than ordinary thermite, [1] it has useful military applications in cutting through tank armor or other hardened military vehicles or bunkers. As with thermite, thermate's ability to burn without an external supply of <u>oxygen</u> renders it useful for underwater incendiary devices.

Another recipe found was the making of thermite to mix with clay. Play Doh could also be used as a substitute for the clay. In researching this it appears the thermite and clay could be molded into any shape.

There are references to chloroform, chlorine gas, magnesiam slivers to aid in ignition and a ball mill. In researching a ball mill, I found that one of the uses is the manufacturing of black powder or gun powder. Regardless of the explanations Mr. Morley may voice, it is very obvious that the formulas and other items mention are meant to and would do serious harm to persons or property. The items described do not have a normal everyday function.


The shaving found in the coffee grinder will be submitted to the Mass. State Police Laboratory for analysis.

Lasked Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss about the burnt green plush animal found on the table used by Mr. Morley. Mr. Morley and his ex-girlfriend each had the same stuffed animal during their relationship. I was advised that Mr. Morley was out in the screen room and began stabbing the stuffed toy with a knife several times. He then burnt the stuffed toy and put it up to Mr. Bloss's face.

A photo of the toy that Mr. Morley burnt and repeatedly stabbed with a knife is below.






GYM BAG

RUBBER GLOVES INSIDE GYM BAG




PRESSURE COOKER

18 OF 25 FME 6/19/13 Mr. Morley was charged with 2 counts of Domestic Assault and Battery, Threats and Conveying a Bomb Threat, transported to Beverly Hospital and later transported to Bridgewater State Hospital pending his appearance at Ipswich District Court on Monday, June 10, 2013. Emergency 209a orders were sought by Mr. Bloss and Ms. Duckworth and granted.

On Monday June 10, 2013, Linterviewed Ms. Duckworth and Mr. Bloss about the incident and Daniel. Ms. Duckworth advised me that she was granted custody of Daniel when she and her Husband, Peter Morley, divorced. At that time Daniel was 13 – 14 years old. Ms. Duckworth brought Daniel back to the United Kingdom with her. She stated Daniel refused to go to school and stayed in his room. Daniel did not have any friends in England and at one point Danield removed the doorknob to his room so Ms. Duckworth did not enter.

Do to the fact that Daniel refused to go to school, Ms. Duckworth sent Daniel back to the United States to live with his father.

Ms. Duckworth stated Daniel had a problem with going to school. She felt that Daniel may have thought school was below him. Daniel was employed at MIT in the animal laboratory. While riding his bicycle in Boston, Daniel was struck from behind by a hit and run driver. Daniel was not wearing a helmet at the time and may have suffered a "brain bleed". Daniel was residing in Brookline at the time of the accident. While Daniel was out of work, his lease was up and Ms. Duckworth allowed Daniel to move back in her home. According to Ms. Duckworth she was supporting Daniel while he lived there.

Daniel had very few friends while he resided at 18 Washington Street in Topsfield. Both Mr. Bloss and Ms. Duckworth stated that they knew of Liz and Ramon who resided with Daniel, however they did not know their last names. Daniel kept his life rather secretive from them.

They stated Daniel's best friend was Marc Pasciuto of Medford. Mr. Bloss stated that Marc was someone who we should check out. They felt that Marc was more volatile that Daniel. They have met Marc on approx. three occasions. Mr. Bloss described one visit by Marc when he sat in the living room and stated this is great, you can see people coming and have time to grab you gun. Mr. Bloss felt that Marc was looking at his home as a fortress and not a residence. Mr. Bloss stated that Daniel told them that Marc stated he knew Tamerlan Tzarnaev, suspect in the Boston Marathon bombing, and either boxed against him or boxed with him. They stated that Marc wasn't truthful however.

I asked Mr. Bloss and Ms. Duckworth if Daniel had the pressure cooker prior to the Boston Marathon and they stated he did. Ms. Duckworth stated that the first thing Mr. Bloss asked her when the bombing occurred in Boston was "where's your son". Ms. Duckworth stated that

Daniel was sleeping. She was shocked to hear Daniel's response when she informed him of the bombing. Daniel stated "What's the big deal, people are dying all over the place", Ms. Duckworth tried to tell Daniel that some of the victims may be their neighbors and was amazed to see that Daniel had no remorse for the carnage.


Ms. Duckworth stated that Daniel had broken off the relationship with Marc approx. two weeks prior. Daniel then became more reclusive and began to drink some alcohol, something that he not normally did. Daniel advised his mother that he separated from Marc because Marc was attempting to have him do something really bad, that Daniel did not want to do. He advised his mother that he needed to get away from his friends and start fresh.

The evening prior to the assault, Daniel and his mother were conversing at the kitchen table when Daniel stated "I'm sorry for what I've done with Marc and I will have to answer only to God". Daniel would not elaborate on what was done.


Mr. Bloss stated that Daniel had an IQ in the high 130's or low 140's. He described Daniel as someone that would always read. They both stated Daniel would read about religions. I asked them if Daniel had Muslim beliefs and the advised me that he did read the Quran and remove the book from the shelf. Ms. Duckworth stated that he was into Budhism before and recently advised her that he wanted to start going to mass with her at Trinity Church.


I was advised that Daniel had been at different events such as Occupy Wallstreet in New York, where he was arrested, and Occupy Boston.





According to the Daniel was anti-government and also anti-Semitic and was very unfavorable towards Isreal. They advised me that Daniel seemed fascinated with fire and believed woman destroy men in accordance with Jobe in the Bible.

They advised me that Daniel also had a Russian friend they only knew as Vlad. They had no idea about the weapons he had and would get extremely angry if his room was entered. Daniel would also advise them that we "were slaves to the government". Daniel broke up with his girlfriend approx. three weeks ago. They only knew her as Liz.

Mr. Bloss and Ms. Duckworth stated that Daniel was at Marc's beckoned call prior to the relationship ending. They stated marc would call on the phone and Daniel would drop everything to meet with him. Marc did not have a car and Daniel would drive him everywhere. Ms. Duckworth stated that Daniel would come home a lot usually at night and grab his camping gear and state he was camping with Marc.

There was a bookcase located in the living room with books that Daniel has read. Photos of the books were taken and are available.

A photo of the painting and triangle were sent to Clairissa Breen, Ph.D., an Assistant Professor at Cazenovia College Director in Criminal Justice and Homeland Security Studies. Dr. Breen has researched Catastrophic criminology, terrorism, hate groups, political and historical crime, criminological theory, criminal tattoos, geography of crime, displacement and disruption, policy analysis and program evaluation. Dr. Breen is a certified Anti-Terrorism Specialist and has a Ph.D. in criminal justice. She is presently in progress of her doctorate in Theology and has been a member of the Joint Terrorism Task Force in Maryland . Dr. Breen has conducted several presentations regarding crime to the criminal justice community.

Members of the FBI and JTTC came to the Topsfield Police Department to gather information and assist in the investigation. The investigation is on-going.

A warrant to search the residence of 18 Washington Street, as well as warrants to search computers belonging to Daniel Morley will be applied for at Ipswich District Court.

The following is Dr. Breen's analysis of the painting:

The first image appears to be very direct – honestly, my heart is gone, there is nothing there, no love, no compassion, I am prepared and ready to fight. Perhaps showing two separate means of attack – a crashed plane directed by others and himself engaging in a shoot out- probably not one he would expect to survive. Leads me to think that his trigger was more or less a romantic relationship rather than the loss of the job, but it depends on when each took place and when this was painted. While very stylized, the image does seem to match up with a portion of the Boston skyline, circled below. This could mean that something in that area is a target, or it could be artistic license.

- 5. Daniel Morley had a Russian friend only know as "Vlad".
- 6. The pressure cooker and other items were purchased prior to the Boston Marathon bombing.
- 7. Daniel Morley had strong anti-government beliefs as well as anti-Semetic beliefs.
- 8. A painting located on a temple made by Daniel Morley was analyzed by Dr. Breen, an expert as possibly containing a skyline in Boston and a plane that may be a potential target area.
